**Bill Analysis**

SB 698 modifies language regarding class size limitations. It clarifies that penalties for exceeding class size limitations are not to be imposed if the limitations were exceeded after October 1, rather than after the first nine weeks. The bill also modifies the classes that are not subject to the class size limitations to include fine arts, careers/exploration, and library science. It directs the class size count to be taken on October 1, rather than a date in October set by the State Board of Education.
