Bill Analysis

SB 767 creates the Fair Chance Hiring Practices by Public Employers Act. The measure prohibits public employers from obtaining criminal history record information relating to the applicant or asking an applicant to disclose their criminal history. This prohibition shall not apply to sensitive positions, private contractors, or positions that require the employer to consider an employee's criminal history. The measure authorizes public employers to provide information to applicants relating to crimes that would disqualify employment.
