**ESTIMATED REVENUE IMPACT:**

**ANALYSIS:** This measure amends 68 O.S. § 2397 of the Oklahoma Tourism Development Act by increasing the annual limit on cumulative claims from \$30,000,000 to \$50,000,000. Additionally, it extends the Act's sunset date from January 1, 2026, to January 1, 2032. A revenue impact is not anticipated following this proposal, as the Oklahoma Tourism Development Act includes revenue-neutral provisions.
