## Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

For the 2025-26 and 2026-27 school years school districts shall provide meals at no cost to a child whose annual household income during the preceding year did not exceed 250% of the federal poverty level.

The Department reviewed all meals served in SY 23-24, less the reimbursement difference of the free and paid rate for both breakfast and lunch. Lunch cost is \$63,113,951 and for breakfast the amount is \$15,577,720. The reduced counts for lunch is \$17,621,336 and breakfast is \$5,747,700. Total approximate cost is \$102,060,708.
