Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB 940 directs the Conservation Commission to implement a statewide plan for the control, removal, and eradication of harmful woody species on state-owned, -leased, or -operated land, as well as directs various agencies as specified in the proposal to compile a report and present it to the Legislature to determine the affected inventory and plan to control or remove woody species.
