8 PROPOSED POLICY COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

9 An Act relating to municipal audits; re-creating the  
10 Special Investigative Unit Auditing Revolving Fund;  
11 providing funding sources; providing purpose of fund;  
12 providing for codification; and providing an  
13 effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 17-107B of Title 11, unless  
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 There is hereby re-created in the State Treasury a revolving  
19 fund for the State Auditor and Inspector to be designated the  
20 "Special Investigative Unit Auditing Revolving Fund". The fund  
21 shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations,  
22 and shall consist of all monies received by the State Auditor and  
23 Inspector from funds withheld from a municipality's allocations of  
24 gasoline taxes as provided in Section 17-107 of Title 11 of the

1 Oklahoma Statutes, all monies received from legislative  
2 appropriations for the purpose of conducting investigative municipal  
3 audits, and all monies that remain in the Special Investigative Unit  
4 Auditing Revolving Fund created under Section 17-107A of Title 11 of  
5 the Oklahoma Statutes. All monies accruing to the credit of such  
6 fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the  
7 State Auditor and Inspector for the purpose of offsetting expenses  
8 incurred from special investigative audit activities relating to  
9 municipal government. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon  
10 warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as  
11 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and  
12 Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
