| 12 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA: |
| 13 | SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 1135.5, as |
| 14 | last amended by Section 1, Chapter 88, O.S.L. 2024 (47 O.S. Supp. |
| 15 | 2024, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows: |
| 16 | Section 1135.5. A. Service Oklahoma is hereby authorized to |
| 17 | design and issue appropriate official special license plates to |
| 18 | persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide financial |
| 19 | assistance as provided by this section. |
| 20 | Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other |
| 21 | person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of |
| 22 | ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used |
| 23 | on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been |
| 24 | registered for the current year with a licensed operator. |

1 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by Service 2 Oklahoma or a licensed operator, unless authorized by Service Oklahoma to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year. 3 Service Oklahoma shall notify by mail all persons issued special 4 5 license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon 6 presentation to a licensed operator or Service Oklahoma. 7 The license plates shall be issued on a staggered system. 8

9 Service Oklahoma is hereby directed to develop and implement a system whereby licensed operators are permitted to accept 10 applications for special license plates authorized under this 11 12 section. The licensed operator shall confirm the applicant's eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 13 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 14 information directly into such system and generate a receipt 15 accordingly. For performance of these duties, licensed operators 16 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 17 registration of a motor vehicle through June 30, 2025. Through June 18 30, 2025, the licensed operator fees for acceptance of applications 19 and renewals shall be paid out of the Service Oklahoma Reimbursement 20 Fund. Beginning July 1, 2023, fees shall be retained by the 21 licensed operator pursuant to subsection E of Section 1141.1 of this 22 title. 23

1 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1, 2 2006, Service Oklahoma shall discontinue issuance and renewal of 3 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special 4 5 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration 6 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be 7 removed from the vehicle. 8

9 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special license plates shall be developed or issued by Service 10 Oklahoma until Service Oklahoma receives one hundred prepaid 11 12 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by Service Oklahoma within one hundred eighty (180) days of the 13 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall 14 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are 15 not received by Service Oklahoma within such prescribed time period 16 any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly. 17

B. The special license plates provided by this section are as follows:

University or College Supporter License Plate - such plates
 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

Environmental Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be 2 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to Service Oklahoma by the Department of Environmental Quality in consultation 3 with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to 4 5 demonstrate support to implement the statewide general public Environmental Education Program created pursuant to the provisions 6 of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such plates shall be 7 designed and issued to any person in any combination of numbers and 8 9 letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license 10 plates. A dealer's license plate issued pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated an Environmental Awareness 11 12 License Plate upon payment of the fee imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License 13 and Registration Act. As provided in this section, an amount of the 14 fee collected shall be apportioned pursuant to Section 1104.2 of 15 this title; 16

3. Firefighter License Plate - such plates shall be designed 17 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid. 18 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four 19 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a 20 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an 21 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department. 22 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of 23 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to 24

provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any 1 2 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated 3 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon 4 5 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire department by either an identification card or letter from the chief 6 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in 7 consultation with the Oklahoma State Firefighters Association. 8

9 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
10 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
11 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma State Firefighters Museum
12 and the Oklahoma Fallen and Living Firefighters Memorial;

4. Wildlife Conservation License Plate - such plates shall be 13 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to Service 14 Oklahoma by the Department of Wildlife Conservation in consultation 15 with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to 16 demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in this state through 17 the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in Section 3-310 of Title 18 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may be designed and issued 19 to any person as for personalized license plates. 20

As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plate - such plates shall be
 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to Service
 Oklahoma by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
 Department of Health and the Child Abuse Prevention Action
 Committee, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
 for the prevention of child abuse.

7 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected8 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

9 6. United States Olympic and Paralympic Committee Supporter 10 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the United States Olympic 11 12 and Paralympic Committee. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of 13 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain 14 the official United States Olympic and Paralympic Committee logo. 15 Service Oklahoma shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a 16 licensing agreement with the United States Olympic and Paralympic 17 Committee for any licensing fees which may be required in order to 18 use the United States Olympic and Paralympic Committee logo or 19 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not 20 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate 21 issued; 22

As 6 provided in this section, an amount of the fee 7 collected for each vehicle license plate shall be 8 9 apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving Fund to be distributed to the Oklahoma Route 10 66 Museum located in Clinton, Oklahoma, and 11 12 b. motorcycle plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Route 66 Association, Inc. Service 13 Oklahoma shall be authorized to enter into a licensing 14 agreement with the Oklahoma Route 66 Association, 15 Inc., for any licensing fees which may be required in 16 order to use the Oklahoma Route 66 Association, Inc., 17 logo or design. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plate - such plates 4 5 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. 6 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma 7 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As 8 9 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be 10 deposited in the Oklahoma Department of Commerce Revolving Fund created in Section 5012 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes; 11

12 17. Support Education License Plate - such plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to Service Oklahoma by 13 the State Department of Education in consultation with the Oklahoma 14 Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 15 support for education in this state.
