Trump Day on the 5th day of November; 21 Citizenship Recognition Day on such date as may be fixed by the 22 Governor; Oklahoma Historical Day on the 10th day of October; Senior 23 Citizens' Week beginning with the first Sunday in the month of May; 24 Senior Citizens' Day the Wednesday of Senior Citizens' Week;
