12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1022 of Title 82, unless there
15	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. As used in this section:
17	1. "Basin" means a major groundwater basin or minor groundwater
18	basin as defined in Section 1020.1 of Title 82 of the Oklahoma
19	Statutes; and
20	2. "Domestic use" means domestic use as defined in Section
21	1020.1 of Title 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
22	B. A moratorium is hereby established on the issuance of any
23	regular, temporary, or special permit for groundwater use, other

than for domestic use. Except as provided for in this section, no

permit may be issued for the use of groundwater from any basin in this state until the Oklahoma Water Resources Board completes a hydrological study and approves a maximum annual yield for a particular basin that will ensure that any permit for the removal of water from the groundwater basin will not reduce the natural flow of water from springs or streams emanating from the basin. Once the study and determination of maximum annual yield is completed, the Board may resume the issuance of groundwater permits for such basin.

- C. 1. The provisions of this section shall be applicable to any groundwater permit application for which no final adjudication has been made by the Oklahoma Water Resources Board before the effective date of this act.
- 2. Any revalidation of a temporary permit in effect upon the effective date of this act shall be considered a new permit application and subject to the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
