12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1289.24e, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 1289.24e. A. The State Legislature hereby occupies and
16	preempts the entire field of legislation by any agency of this state
17	or any political subdivision in this state to infringe upon the
18	rights of a citizen of <del>the State of Oklahoma</del> this state, the
19	unalienable right to keep and bear arms as guaranteed to them by the
20	Second Amendment of the United States Constitution.
21	B. Any federal, state, county, or municipal act, law, executive
22	order, administrative order, court order, rule, policy <u>,</u> or
23	regulation ordering the buy-back, confiscation <u>,</u> or surrender of
24 27	firearms, firearm accessories, or ammunition from law-abiding

<sup>1</sup> citizens of this state shall be considered an infringement on the <sup>2</sup> rights of citizens to keep and bear arms as guaranteed by the Second <sup>3</sup> Amendment of the Constitution of the United States and Article II, <sup>4</sup> Section 26 of the Constitution of Oklahoma United States <sup>5</sup> Constitution and Section 26 of Article II of the Oklahoma <sup>6</sup> Constitution.

7 C. It shall be the duty of the courts and law enforcement 8 agencies of this state to protect the rights of law-abiding citizens 9 to keep and to bear arms within the borders of this state and to 10 protect these rights from the infringement provided under the 11 provisions of this act the Second Amendment Sanctuary State Act. 12 D. The preemption provided in this act the Second Amendment 13 Sanctuary State Act shall include: 14 1. Any regulation of arms and ammunition, pursuant to the

<sup>16</sup> the effective date of this act <u>April 26, 2021</u>; and

Any regulations regulation or provision of the Gun Control
 Act of 1968, prohibited or regulated on or after the effective date

E. The sheriff of each county shall be empowered and have the authority to implement the provisions of this section including, but not limited to, the arrest of any federal employee, contractor, agent, or law enforcement officer who violates the provisions of this section.

F. Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in the county jail for a term not more than one (1) year and one (1) day, or by a fine not more than Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00), or by both such imprisonment and fine.

G. For purposes of this section:

<sup>7</sup> 1. "Arms" is defined as <u>means</u> any firearm, firearm part, <sup>8</sup> accessory, or ammunition required to render that firearm operable <sup>9</sup> and effective;

<sup>10</sup> 2. "Infringement" shall mean means any law that reduces, <sup>11</sup> represses, diminishes, or subverts the right to keep and bear arms, <sup>12</sup> ammunition, parts, and accessories in any amount that is legal as of <sup>13</sup> the effective date of this act <u>April 26, 2021</u>, of any citizen in <sup>14</sup> this state; and

<sup>15</sup> 3. "Law-abiding citizen" means a person who is not otherwise
<sup>16</sup> precluded under state law from possessing a firearm and shall not be
<sup>17</sup> construed to include anyone who is not legally present in the United
<sup>18</sup> States or this state.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
