The State Legislature hereby occupies and 16 preempts the entire field of legislation by any agency of this state 17 or any political subdivision in this state to infringe upon the 18 rights of a citizen of the State of Oklahoma this state, the 19 unalienable right to keep and bear arms as guaranteed to them by the 20 Second Amendment of the United States Constitution. 21 Any federal, state, county, or municipal act, law, executive 22 order, administrative order, court order, rule, policy, or

ammunition from law-abiding citizens of this state shall be considered an infringement on the rights of citizens to keep and bear arms as guaranteed by the Second Amendment of the Constitution of the United States and Article II, Section 26 of the Constitution of Oklahoma United States Constitution and Section 26 of Article II of the Oklahoma Constitution.

- C. It shall be the duty of the courts and law enforcement agencies of this state to protect the rights of law-abiding citizens to keep and to bear arms within the borders of this state and to protect these rights from the infringement provided under the provisions of this act the Second Amendment Sanctuary State Act.
- D. The preemption provided in this act the Second Amendment Sanctuary State Act shall include:
- 1. Any regulation of arms and ammunition, pursuant to the National Firearms Act of 1934, prohibited or regulated on or after the effective date of this act April 26, 2021; and
- 2. Any regulations regulation or provision of the Gun Control Act of 1968, prohibited or regulated on or after the effective date of this act April 26, 2021.
  - E. For purposes of this section:
- 1. "Arms" is defined as means any firearm, firearm part, accessory, or ammunition required to render that firearm operable and effective;

"Infringement" shall mean means any law that reduces, 2 represses, diminishes, or subverts the right to keep and bear arms, 3 ammunition, parts, and accessories in any amount that is legal as of the effective date of this act April 26, 2021, of any citizen in 5 this state; and 6 3. "Law-abiding citizen" means a person who is not otherwise precluded under state law from possessing a firearm and shall not be 8 construed to include anyone who is not legally present in the United 9 States or this state. 10 SECTION 2.
