C. The following state employees shall be exempt from the requirements in subsection A of this section:

5 1. Officers and members of the Oklahoma State Regents for 6 Higher Education and state employees of institutions under the 7 administrative authority of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher 8 Education; and

9 2. Physicians and other licensed health care professionals 10 under the administrative authority of any state department or 11 agency.

D. State employee compensation greater than the Governor's may be submitted to the Legislature by the director of the respective state department, agency, or political subdivision. The Legislature may approve such compensation by the proper passage of a joint or concurrent resolution.

17SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.18SECTION 3.
