"State agency" means any office, elected or appointed officer, bureau, board, commission, counsel, unit, division, body, authority, or institution of the executive branch of state government excluding institutions within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education, the Oklahoma Municipal Power Authority, the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, the Oklahoma State

 Bureau of Investigation, the District Attorneys Council, the Office of the Attorney General, the Office of the State Auditor and Inspector, and the telecommunications network known as OneNet.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.

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
