SENATE BILL 802

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health; prohibiting manufacture or sale of food containing vaccine or vaccine material; defining term; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1332 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. No person or entity in this state shall manufacture, sell, or deliver, hold, or offer for sale any food that contains a vaccine or vaccine material.

B. As used in this section, "vaccine or vaccine material" means a substance intended for use in humans to stimulate the production of antibodies and provide immunity against disease, prepared from the causative agent of a disease, its products, or a synthetic substitute, treated to act as an antigen without inducing the disease, that is authorized or approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration.

1 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
