16	school in this state may <u>shall</u> display in each classroom, school
17	auditorium, and school cafeteria under their supervision the
18	following motto of the United States of America: "E PLURIBUS UNUM
19	(Out of Many <u>,</u> One)" and "IN GOD WE TRUST". For purposes of this
20	subsection, "classroom" means any room of a public school where
21	instruction takes place.
22	B. Each school district in the state shall permit a principal
23	or teacher to utilize in a public school building, classroom, or at
24	any public school event any grade-level-appropriate excerpts or
