L5	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
L 6	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-60.7 of Title 2, unless there
L7	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry

shall operate an "Oklahoma Local Food for Schools" program for the purpose of facilitating the purchase of local foods by school districts.

B. The Department shall encourage school districts to partner with local producers and meat processors by providing reimbursement to the school district for local food costs.

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C. The Department is authorized to promulgate rules necessary for the implementation of this act.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-60.8 of Title 2, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to be designated the "Oklahoma Local Food for Schools Revolving Fund".

The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the Department from legislative appropriations for the purpose of facilitating the purchase of local food by school districts pursuant to the Oklahoma Local Food for Schools program created in Section 1 of this act. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be expended by the Department for the purpose provided for in this section. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.

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
