12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 1-124, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 1-124. A. Unless otherwise specifically defined, "per-
16	pupil expenditure" shall mean the aggregate current expenditures of
17	school districts, from all funding sources including federal funds,
18	state funds and local funds, plus the direct support aggregate
19	current expenditures of the state for the day-to-day operations of
20	schools and school districts from all funding sources including
21	federal funds, divided by the aggregate student membership number
22	for the same fiscal year for which the expenditures are determined.
23	The aggregate student membership number shall be the count of
24	students enrolled on October 1 or the school day closest to October

 - 7. 9. Operation and maintenance of plant services;

- 17 12. Enterprise services.
- B. Aggregate current expenditures shall not include
 expenditures for adult and community education, facilities
 acquisition and construction services, debt services, property, and
 other expenditures not related to the day-to-day operations.
- C. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall apply
 when related to the expenditure of public funds by educational and
 governmental entities. When reporting or publishing the per-pupil
