HOUSE BILL 2451

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to a constitutional convention; ordering a legislative referendum pursuant to the Oklahoma Constitution; presenting the question for approval by the People of the State of Oklahoma for a constitutional convention; providing ballot title; and directing filing.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 3 of Article V of the Oklahoma Constitution, there is hereby ordered the following legislative referendum which shall be filed with the Secretary of State and addressed to the Governor of the state, who shall submit the same to the people for their approval or rejection at the next General Election.

Shall a constitutional convention be called pursuant to Section 2 of Article 24 of the Oklahoma Constitution?

SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Question as set forth in SECTION 1 of this measure shall be in the following form:

9 SECTION 3. The Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives,
10 immediately after the passage of this act, shall prepare and file
11 one copy thereof, including the Ballot Title set forth in SECTION 2
12 hereof, with the Secretary of State and one copy with the Attorney
13 General.
