Research Analysis

HB 1050 as introduced, prohibits counties and municipalities from imposing minimum parking mandates for residential, commercial, or industrial properties within its jurisdiction. A *minimum parking mandate* is defined in the measure as a law that specifies a number of off-street parking spaces.

HB 1050 prohibits the establishment of minimum parking mandates by a political subdivision within its jurisdiction. The measure does not mandate any action or expenditure by a state agency.
