## **Research Analysis**

HB 1126, as introduced, prohibits the manufacture, sale, or distribution of cultivated meat in the state. Individuals found to violate this will guilty of a misdemeanor. The license of a food seller may also be suspended or revoked upon a violation of this measure. Cultivated meat is defined as meat or a meat product produced from cultured animal tissue produced from in vitro animal cell cultures outside of the animal. The State Department of Health may adopt necessary rules. Nothing in this measure prohibits conducting research involving the production of cultivated meat products.
