Fiscal Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to HB 1375 requires the Corporation Commission to contract with an outside consulting firm regarding a nuclear energy feasibility study. The measure sets an expenditure limit of Three Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$375,000) for the Corporation Commission to conduct the study. Therefore, the fiscal impact of this measure has a maximum amount of \$375,000 to state appropriations.
