**Research Analysis**

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 1466 gives school districts the opportunity to request a hearing before the State Board of Education if the State Board is considering a reduction in the district's accreditation status. The school district is required to request a hearing within 10 days of notification from the State Board. If the district does not request a hearing within 10 days, their right to one is waived.

The measure details the procedure for the hearing, which includes:

- The State Board of Education must hold the hearing within 30 days of notification from the district;
- The Board may appoint a hearing officer; and
- Only evidence relevant to the district's alleged deficiencies may be considered.
