HB 1467, as introduced, allows the State Board of Education to award grants to districts for the creation of community school pilot projects. Projects can include entire districts or individual school sites. Plans for pilot projects must include a project coordinator, a comprehensive needs assessment, site-based collaborative leadership, and an ongoing stakeholder engagement process.
