HB 1543, as introduced, allows the Conservation Commission to enter into contracts with Conservation district directors to fulfill its duties. The measure updates language to clarify the Commission can work with tribes. And lastly, the measure removes the ability of the Commission to maintain a Conservation District Consolidation Fund.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1543 allows the Conservation Commission to enter into specific contracts and agreements, adds tribes as a entity the Commission can work with, and removes the un-used Conservation District Consolidation Fund from statute.
