HB 1758, as introduced, provides virtual charter schools that earn a composite academic achievement score that is within 10 points of the state average with \$100,000 for specific expenses.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure in its current form would pay virtual charter schools \$100,000 for certain resources if the school achieves a certain academic score. The number of schools that may achieve this goal and benefit from this incentive is not known. According to the Statewide Charter School Board, of the 7 virtual charter schools, there are 3 that are considered very close to that academic score.
