Research Analysis

HB 1934 creates the Jamie Lea Pearl Act. The measure establishes the requirements for a medical needs motor carrier to provide for the transportation of passengers and their baggage at little or no cost for medical needs, including, but not limited to, dialysis, cancer treatments, prosthetics, pain management, and physical rehabilitation. A medical needs motor carrier may engage in the transportation of passengers and their baggage, by use of vehicles for hire as necessary for the company to generate sufficient revenue to cover their cost of operations.
