## **Research Analysis**

HB 2069 as introduced, repeals <u>Title 21 Section 1755</u>, which relates to injury to toll house or turnpike gate and <u>Title 47 Section 11-806.2</u>, which relates to exceeding speed limit in properly marked toll booth zone. In effect, the measure removes the felony violation for maliciously damaging a turnpike toll booth. The measure also removes the requirement of doubling fines for drivers charged with speeding in a toll booth zone.
