## **Research Analysis**

HB 2083 as introduced, adds to the list of positions exempted from the dual office holding provision.

The exemptions as laid out in the measure include:

- Municipal law enforcement officers who are elected to a position in a municipality, which is not the same municipality the officer performs law enforcement services;
- Municipal law enforcement officers who are elected to a position in a county, which does not include any of the municipality in which the officer performs law enforcement services;
- Deputy sheriffs who are elected to a position in a county, which is not the same county the deputy sheriff performs law enforcement services;
- Deputy sheriffs who are elected to a position in a municipality, which is not located in the county the deputy sheriff performs law enforcement duties; and
- University campus police officers who are elected to a position for any county or municipality.
