**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute to HB 2299, designated as the Dr. Tom Coburn Act, provides for the definition of *commissioner* to mean a person delegated to represent Oklahoma at an Article V Convention and establishes that a commissioner or an alternate commissioner is not allowed to exceed the scope of their authority by voting or acting beyond what was granted in their original commission. Violators are guilty of a felony if convicted. The measure also establishes that any person who knowingly bribes, threatens, intimidates, or obstructs a commissioner, alternate commissioner, or person representing another state at a convention held in Oklahoma is guilty of a felony if convicted.
