Research Analysis

HB 2299 as introduced, provides for the definition of *commissioner* to mean a person delegated to represent Oklahoma at an Article V Convention and establishes that a commissioner or an interim commissioner is not allowed to exceed the scope of their authority by voting or acting beyond what was granted in their original commission. Violators are guilty of a felony if convicted. The measure also establishes that any person who knowingly bribes, threatens, intimidates, or obstructs a commissioner, interim commissioner, or person representing another state at a convention held in Oklahoma is guilty of a felony if convicted.
