HB 2891, as introduced, exempts the Tourism and Recreation Department from the Central Purchasing Act for purchases of merchandise for resale and for materials, supplies, and services needed to generate revenue at its facilities or programs.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2891 exempts the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department (OTRD) from the Central Purchasing Act for specific purchases that assist in generating revenue for agency facilities or programs. Per OTRD, these exemptions would allow for increased efficiency and competitiveness in the hospitality industry, resulting in maintaining current revenue levels used to support the agency's budget and preventing a reduction in agency services at various locations across the state.
