**Bill Analysis**

SB 1009 defines basin integrity study as a scientific study to determine sustainable instream flow regimes tailored for certain basins in certain seasons in this state. The measure requires the results from such studies to meet the demand of consumptive and nonconsumptive uses. Additionally, it states that such studies shall not be construed as a means to revoke private water rights or interfere with senior water permitting.
