Bill Analysis

SB 1070 creates Kenny's Law. The measure requires the gates of an enclosure containing livestock to remain closed at all times unless an ingress or egress of livestock is currently in progress, maintenance is in progress on the property, livestock are being moved from one area to another, or the owner has a functional reason to access the area. Individuals in violation of this requirement or who purposefully damage such gates shall be subject to a maximum fine of \$1,000.00 and/or a term of imprisonment not to exceed 180 days for each separate offense. The penalties are increased for third and subsequent violations. The penalty increases to \$2,500.00 and/or 1 year. Individuals who violate these provisions shall also be liable for damages.
