**Bill Analysis**

SB 1096 requires any bill mandating insurance coverage to be assigned to the respective Senate or House standing committee or subcommittee that is primarily responsible for the consideration of insurance legislation. The measure requires such legislation to first receive a majority vote to conduct an impact analysis of the bill by the Insurance Department. The analysis shall consider the social impact, the medical efficacy, and the financial impact of the bill. The measure authorizes the Department to contract with third-party vendors to conduct the analysis. Any amendment to the bill may be submitted to the Department after receiving approval from the Floor Leader of the respective chamber of the Legislature. After receiving the impact analysis, the bill may be voted out of committee to the floor for consideration.

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
