**Bill Analysis**

SB 557 expands the scope of the state's preemption on regulating firearms to include ammunition. Additionally, the measure provides that the court may require a person, municipality, agency, or political subdivision to pay reasonable expenses to the aggrieved party in a civil action if the aggrieved party first provides written notice to the entity that an ordinance or regulation violates the state's preemption.
