Bill Analysis

SB 864 provides that any person who has been convicted, plead nolo contendere, or received a suspended sentence for a crime which requires the person to register as a sex offender to not enter into a plea agreement that allow the offender to not register as sex offender. The measure also provides that sealing a record involved in such a crime shall not remove the requirement of the offender to register.
