**Bill Analysis**

SB 882 prohibits the release of any person arrested for a second driving under the influence violation without the granting of bail. The authority determining the bail shall consider any evidence that the person is dependent upon alcohol or a controlled dangerous substance or has a pattern of regular abuse of alcohol or the illegal use of any controlled dangerous substance. The measure strikes language requiring officers to test any driver involved in an accident that resulted in a death or injury for substances.
