**Bill Analysis**

SB 91 creates the Spring Creek Watershed Study Act. The measure directs the Oklahoma Conservation Commission to begin a comprehensive water quality study of the Spring Creek Watershed located in Cherokee, Delaware, and Mayes counties near Kansas, Oklahoma in partnership with relevant nonprofit organizations and government agencies. Findings from the study shall be used to implement voluntary, incentive-based conservation practices. The measure also creates the Spring Creek Watershed Water Quality Advisory Group as well as a technical advisory group. Both advisory groups shall assist the Commission in developing the report as well as recommend policies incentivize participation. The measure also creates the Spring Creek Watershed Study Revolving Fund.
