Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB 184 has the Department of Human Services extend benefits under Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) to those individuals who qualify for Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF). The program will also have an income limit of 170% of the federal poverty line and have no asset limit.

DHS believes there to be approximately 341,556 individuals that could qualify for this program. With federal support, DHS believes the cost to implement would be \$19,020,000 for additional staffing needs; of which the state share would be \$9,660,000.
