## Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB 190 has the Department of Human Services develop simplified certification and recertification requirements for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program for an individual who is 60 years old or disabled, with no income, and lives in a household in which every person is either disabled or 60 years of age or older.

DHS has an estimated cost of approximately \$2,500,000, of which the state share would be \$1,250,000. This impact also includes a personnel cost of 2 additional FTE.
