**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 280 creates the Feral Swine Eradication and Control Grant Program, providing Oklahomans with education, equipment, and services associated with the eradication and control of feral swine, and directs the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry (ODAFF) to coordinate with the Department of Wildlife Conservation and the Oklahoma Conservation Commission to distribute resources for capturing or eradicating feral swine.

ODAFF states there would be no fiscal impact for the administration of this act.
