15	Section 701.9. A. <u>1.</u> A person who is convicted of or pleads
16	guilty or nolo contendere to murder in the first degree shall be
17	punished by death, by imprisonment for life without parole or by
18	imprisonment for life. A person who is convicted of or pleads
19	guilty or nolo contendere to murder in the first degree, as
20	described in subsection E of Section 701.7 of this title, shall be
21	punished by death or by life without parole and absent an
22	overwhelming amount of mitigating evidence shall not be entitled to
23	or afforded the benefit of receiving imprisonment for life or
24	deferment of the sentence.

1	2. A foreign-born person who, at the time of committing murder
2	in the first degree, was present in the United States without valid
3	immigration documentation or violated the terms of his or her
4	admission to the United States, is convicted of or pleads guilty or
5	nolo contendere to murder in the first degree shall be punished by
6	death.
7	B. A person who is convicted of or pleads guilty or nolo
8	contendere to murder in the second degree shall be guilty of a
9	felony punishable by imprisonment in the custody of the Department
10	of Corrections for not less than ten (10) years nor more than life.
11	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
