22	promulgated by the Department. An inspection and evaluation may be

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announced or unannounced with higher risk facilities receiving more

frequent inspections and evaluations.

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B. The Department shall further allow elected state officials access to inmates incarcerated at said facilities upon request by elected state officials.

C. The Department shall implement the necessary security protocols to manage said visits without compromising the safety and security of the facility, its inmates, correctional officers, and
