- C. The Oklahoma Department of Transportation shall collaborate with the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department to maintain online resources for the True Grit Trail, including but not limited to:
- 9 1. A map of the True Grit Trail;
 - 2. Information about each of the sites of significant interest identified in this section; and
 - 3. Historical context regarding the True Grit Trail.
 - D. The cost associated with signage required by this act may be provided from private sources and may include the costs of the initial erection of signs as well as the cost of potential replacement or reconstruction of signs. Upon receiving adequate funding, the Oklahoma Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed as required by this act.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
