15	Section 199.4. <u>A.</u> The State Board of Cosmetology and Barbering
16	shall employ an executive director who shall be in charge of the
17	office of the Board. The executive director shall have such
18	qualifications as shall be established by rules of the Board;
19	provided, the executive director shall not be actively engaged in
20	the practice of cosmetology or barbering while serving as executive
21	director. The executive director shall:
22	1. Devote his or her entire time to the duties of the office;
23	2. Receive salary and benefits as provided by law;

1 3. Keep and preserve all books and records pertaining to the 2 Board; 3 4. Have authority, in the name of and in behalf of the Board, 4 to issue all licenses, certificates of registration, permits, 5 orders, and notices; 6 5. Have authority to collect all fees and penalties provided 7 for by the Oklahoma Cosmetology and Barbering Act; 8 6. Make quarterly reports to the Board of all monies collected 9 and the sources from which derived; 10 7. Have authority to approve payrolls and all claims for the 11 Board: 12 8. Have authority to employ staff; 13 9. Keep a continuous inventory of all properties, excluding 14 supplies, belonging to the Board; and 15 10. Perform such other duties as may be directed by the Board. 16 B. The State Board of Cosmetology and Barbering shall employ an 17 assistant executive director who shall assist in all duties of the 18 executive director. The assistant executive director shall: 19 1. Devote his or her entire time to the duties of the office; 20 2. Hold a current Oklahoma master instructor license; and 21 3. Be qualified by education and experience. 22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025. 23
