13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
14	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
15	A. There is hereby appropriated to the County Improvements for
16	Roads and Bridges Fund created pursuant to Section 507 of Title 69
17	of the Oklahoma Statutes from any monies not otherwise appropriated
18	from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal
19	year ending June 30, 2026, the sum of Twenty-five Million Dollars
20	(\$25,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the
21	reconstruction of county bridges on the portion of the county
22	highway system defined as Major Collector routes in accordance with
23	the provisions of Section 654 of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

² with the criteria provided for in this subsection.

B. Bridges proposed for reconstruction will be generally
evaluated based on the state of project innovation, readiness,
structural adequacy, safety, serviceability, functional
obsolescence, essentiality for public use, and special reductions
for characteristics such as detour length, traffic safety features,
and current school bus routes.

9 C. The direct or indirect financial participation by the county 10 proposing the project shall be an additional selection factor for 11 proposed projects, along with the objective distribution of funding.

D. Any approved projects awarded by the Transportation
 Commission shall be contracted as provided by law.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

16 Α. There is hereby appropriated to the County Improvements for 17 Roads and Bridges Fund created pursuant to Section 507 of Title 69 18 of the Oklahoma Statutes from any monies not otherwise appropriated 19 from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal 20 year ending June 30, 2026, the sum of Twenty-five Million Dollars 21 (\$25,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the 22 reconstruction of county roads on the portion of the county highway 23 system defined as Major Collector routes in accordance with the 24 provisions of Section 654 of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes. _ _

Projects proposed by the counties will be submitted to, evaluated, and prioritized by the Department of Transportation in accordance with the criteria provided for in this subsection.

4 B. Roads proposed for reconstruction will be generally 5 evaluated based on the state of project innovation, readiness, the 6 state of operation and repair of any bridge infrastructure within 7 the proposed project limits, drainage characteristics, subgrade and 8 pavement condition, safety, serviceability, essentiality for public 9 use, percentage of truck traffic, and special reductions for 10 characteristics such as detour length, traffic safety features, and 11 current school bus routes.

12 C. The direct or indirect financial participation by the county 13 proposing the project shall be an additional selection factor for 14 proposed projects, along with the objective distribution of funding.

D. Any approved projects awarded by the Transportation
 Commission shall be contracted as provided by law.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025. SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
