Except as otherwise provided in the Oklahoma Minimum 21 Wage Act, no employer within the State of Oklahoma employers of this 22 state shall pay any employee employees a wage of not less than 23 Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) an hour or the current federal minimum 24 wage, whichever is greater, for all hours worked.
