SENATE BILL 435

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to Service Oklahoma; requiring certain directives to be in writing; providing penalty; defining term; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-111 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Any directive or instruction regarding policy and rules that is to be given by an employee of Service Oklahoma to another employee of Service Oklahoma shall be in writing and shall clearly state who is providing the directive or instruction. Any employee who gives a directive or instruction that violates state statute or legislative intent shall be suspended for thirty (30) days without pay.

B. For the purposes of this section "employee of Service Oklahoma" shall mean any individual currently employed by Service Oklahoma, including the Executive Director.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
